## Group to manage Snow King Center to manage skate

Town running low on options as Snow King Center falls into disrepair.

Two groups that once appeared to be leading candidates to manage the Snow King Center have recently expressed reservations or an outright lack of interest in doing so.

Neither Snow King Resort, which has operated the rink and arena space since it opened in 1994, nor Friends of Snow King, the nonprofit group that once sought to run the mountain, are actively seeking to take on a long-term lease for the troubled ice rink, ski shelter and convention center.
